## **SUKE, DASH Highways To Open By 2020**

Two major highway projects costing billions of ringgit are expected to be completed by the end of 2019, benefiting real estate developments within their vicinity. These consists of the 20.1km-long Damansara-Shah Alam Highway (DASH) and Sungai Besi-Ulu Kelang Expressway (SUKE), which spans 24.4 kilometres. The former costs RM4.1 billion to construct, while expenses for the latter amounts to RM4.6 billion.

At present, both major roads are 52 percent complete and they are anticipated to open by mid-2020, said Datuk Mohammad Azlan Abdullah, Group CEO of Projek Lintasan Kota Holdings (Prolintas).

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## **Melaka to spend RM3m a year to build homes for hardcore poor**

The state government here is planning to spend RM3 million a year in a housing programme to help the hardcore poor. The scheme “would include home repairs and building 60 houses annually”. The construction of each house “would cost RM30,000”. the first 30 homes would be located in Pokok Mangga and rented out at RM150 a month to newly married couples for three years.
